Taken from the cross and buried, Matthew 27:57–66; Mark 15:42–47; Luke 23:50–56; John 19:31–42
Arises from the dead, Matthew 28:2–15; Mark 16:1–11; Luke 24:1–12; John 20:1–18
Seen by Mary Magdalene, Matthew 28:1–10; Mark 16:9; John 20:11–17;
 by Peter, Luke 24:34; 1 Cor. 15:5
Appears to two disciples, Mark 16:12, 13; Luke 24:13–35
Appears in the midst of the disciples when Thomas is absent, Mark 16:14–18; Luke 24:36–49; John 20:19–23;
 when Thomas is present, John 20:26–29;
 at the Sea of Galilee, Matthew 28:16; John 21:1–14;
 to the apostles and some five hundred brethren in Galilee, Matthew 28:16–20, with Acts 10:40–42; see also Acts 13:31; 1 Corinthians 15:6, 7
Appears to James and also to all the apostles, Acts 1:3–8; 1 Corinthians 15:7
Ascends to heaven, Mark 16:19, 20; Luke 24:50–53; Acts 1:9–12
